She moved to New York City after graduating the North Carolina School of the Arts, and since has worked successfully in various Broadway and Off-Broadway shows.

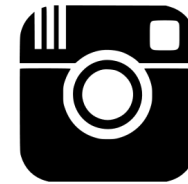
Theater highlights include appearing on Broadway in the American premiere of Tom Stoppard's 11-time Tony-winning *The Coast of Utopia* trilogy and Larry David's hit comedy *Fish in the Dark*. Her off-Broadway credits include A.R. Gurney's *The Wayside Motor Inn*, which won the Drama Desk Ensemble Award, and the premiere of Kenneth Lonergan's *Hold On To Me Darling* at the Atlantic Theatre, which was named one of the best plays of 2016 by the New York Times. In addition, she has originated roles in such world premiere works as John Guare's *Are You There, McPhee?*

Lyon has shared both stage and screen time with Tim Olyphant in *Hold On To Me Darling* and as his love interest in FX's *Justified* Seasons three and four. She also starred opposite George Lopez and Danny Trejo in the sitcom *Saint George*. Other television appearances include *Army Wives*, *Suburgatory*, *Louie* and *Crashing*. Film credits include *Phil Spector*, with Al Pacino and Helen Mirren, and the independent films *Flower Shop* and *Lemon*. Most recently Lyon appeared in the feature film *Blaze* directed by Ethan Hawke which premiered at Sundance.

Lyon is also a writer/producer/co-founder of internet sketch group POYKPAC, which has produced sketches with more than 100 million views to date. They have written for and been seen on MTV, IFC, G4, CBS and CNN.

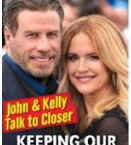

# Jenn Lyon

As a trained theater actor, Jenn Lyon had to learn how to make big stage moments intimate for the screen. Her first recurring television role came in 2012, when she began playing Lindsey Salazar, a thieving bartender on FX's "Justified."

Her first series regular role came in 2014 on FX opposite George Lopez on "Saint George," a job that gave her the confidence to make it through a long day on set. She took that experience with her to TNT's "Claws," the drama where she plays spirited, loyal manicurist Jennifer Husser. Season 2 returns June 10.

**What has playing Jennifer on "Claws" added to your acting skills?** I would say theater actors are used to acting with their whole bodies. With "Claws," these are archetypal characters but set within the backwoods of a Florida swamp culture. It really gives you permission to play it big when the scene demands it. When you're in a strip club and it's a fight scene, you can pull it all out. But if you're in the backyard with your husband talking about sobriety, you might want to rein it in. The language and the circumstances will always reveal to you how you should behave.

**How do you prepare for an audition for this sort of character?** This particular character, I'm very familiar with. I grew up with her. I'm close to her. I'm not as rough and ready as she is, but I know what it's like to not have any money and scrape by and do what you have to do. The way I actually prepared for it [was being] in New York, working at a pizza restaurant. I put on a tank top and a little bit too much makeup and worked on the script a lot the night before. Then I went on the train and I walked into Warner Bros., they worked with me, and [then] I went to the pizza shop and worked my shift. A lot of times, that's the prep. You have the language, you've got to make bold choices, and then you've got to work your day job.

**Other than the pizza restaurant, what was your most memorable survival job?** Being a waitress was always tough for me because everything gets taken out on you: the kitchen gets mad at you, the customers get mad at you. I take on the suffering of whatever's happening around me, so I was like, "Let's work in an ice-cream shop." They let me put my headshot on the bathroom door because I was always running in the bathroom to get ready for an audition.

**Have you used Backstage in the past?** When I found out I got to do an interview with you guys, I felt like I'd finally arrived. Backstage was my bible. When I moved to New York, I moved from a very small town in North Carolina, and I would pore through Backstage for castings [and] advice from other actors. I bought it constantly and kept it with me.

**What other skills have you acquired along the way?** Maintaining your energy level over long days of shooting is a thing you have to learn. You have to learn how to conserve and allocate your energy in the right ways. Any kind of sex scenes are a whole other beast. You have to learn to cover yourself in appropriate ways, how to say yes and no to what you're comfortable with. It's hard in a room full of people to say no or to negotiate what is good for you. That's been a huge lesson for me in being a strong woman: How do I say no and not appear difficult? Or how do I say no, appear difficult, and be fine with it because it's my body? ■

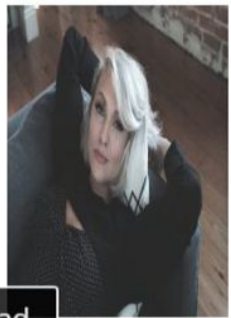

Jenn Lyon, who plays Jennifer, was born and raised in North Carolina. First a star of the stage, the 36-year-old actress made the jump to TV with roles on FX's "Justified" and "Saint George," and guest-starring stints on "Army Wives," "Sabrina" and "I, Jane."  
 With the ninth episode of Season 2 almost done and shooting for episode 10 starting the following week, Lyon squeezed in a quick phone interview while riding around her temporary home, New Orleans. Shooting locations also include Slidell, Westwego and Chalmette.

**To what do you attribute the popularity of the hair-cutting industry?**  
 I think maybe because you've never seen women get to be so badass on TV. I feel like often the woman is the accessory to the man who gets to do the badass s\*\*\*, and then in this one, we're the ones doing the badass s\*\*\*. Also it's women of all different colors and sizes, and they're unapologetic for their sexuality, they're unapologetic for the complicated s\*\*\* they do to survive, and I think it's empowering.

**And there are a lot of carry-overs, yourself included, as the show.**  
 That's what I'm talkin' about. Yeah, I think it's kind of revolutionary to eat food and be on TV, but like that's a reflection of exactly what women should be doing. Like, we should be allowed to take up space, let's take it up.

**What do you consider your character's positive and negative?**  
 Jennifer's positive attributes are that she is extraordinarily loyal, compassionate, maternal

and funny. As far as negative, she's got this hair-trigger temper, like she'll snatch a bitch up by the ponytail in a second, and I think maybe sometimes it's better to take a breath, count to 10, you know, before you get arrested in a bar fight.  
**Near character has a drinking problem and smokes. How is that to deal with?**  
 She is tenuously sober. I don't smoke cigarettes; I definitely used to. But the herbal cigarettes we smoke (take ones for shooting), they don't taste good and can give you a headache, so sometimes I just smoke a regular cigarette, but don't tell my mom! I love a cocktail; I like to have drinks. I'm going to tell you, New Orleans is a difficult town to not have a drink in. I mean you think you're just go-

ing to have one hurricane, and then you wake up in somebody's yard.  
**How do you like being in the city?**  
 I live in the upstairs of a house and it's beautiful. It has a backyard and a swing. I really love it. It's not hot right now, but we've been here since January. It's getting to be that heat that where it's just like, "Oh hell." We have doobies of all the costumes because we sweat so hard. You've got to change into a different version of your costume at lunch because you just can't stop sweating. But the food is so good. The people are so nice. It's fantastic here.  
**And it goes the identity does a number on your hair?**  
 I'm lucky because I wear a

wig in the show, so I'm just in a fakefront fantasy living my best life. But it's also like wearing a fur pelt, so it's hot, but it's easy to keep it looking good.  
**So those up-close with you all how to wear get to your way?**  
 Oh, girl, yes. You don't even think of how difficult it is, like going to the bathroom or running your fingers through your hair. We have to wear press-ons when we're shooting the show because we shoot parts of so many different episodes in a day. We're all moisture loving by now. Just the way you pick up your kids, you grab your purse, it's all different.  
**How is it working alongside the one of the top Niecy Nash (as Desha)?**  
 She is a mess. She is so funny, she is so kind. We call her

"Mama" because if you need a Hand-Aid and she fears you need a Hand-Aid, she's like, "Oh, let me get my purse out," and there'll be Hand-Aids, babying lines, handkerchiefs, a rubber chicken, like she has everything. And she takes care of us. We couldn't ask for a better No. 1.  
**Could you describe Louisiana actress Kevin Kline (who grew up in Morgan City and has a big [of Lafayette], who also star?)**  
 Kevin is my Cajun love. He is wonderful, he's funny, he's inventive, he's a great dad. He's a wonderful TV husband to me. I look for his flaws every day and I just can't seem to find them.

**Evan Daigle — our sweet baby. We love Evan so much. He is just a delight, so sweet, so talented.**  
**Can you give any hints about this season?**  
 You need to hold on to your hats because it's about to get crazy. I will just say that a new boss rolls into town, and it's somebody you've never met before. And if you thought Hiva (the Dixie Mafia's Russian nemesis) was crazy, you ain't seen nothing yet.

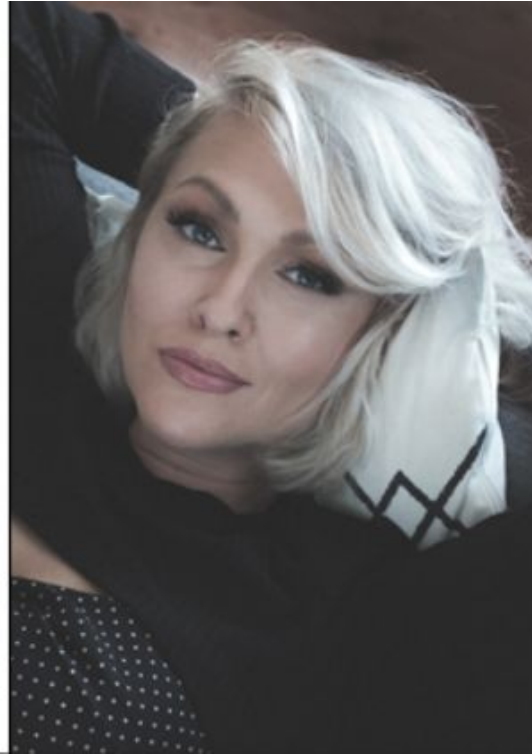
